Student Health & Wellness

1) Child Focus Therapist

Eliminate the wait for kids to meet with a professional therapist as they identify and treat mental health issues as early as possible. The critical tasks of mental health services include promoting healthy relationships, improving behavioral and emotional functioning, thus drastically increasing the likelihood of success in life.

2) Student Connection Assessments

Gathering feedback from students is very important as the district continues to provide an exceptional learning environment.

As a community, it's important for us to hear from our students and the Foundation is proud to support a tool where "their voices" can be heard.

These research-based assessments will be conducted 2-3 times a year which allows the school district to create data driven programs and resources for continued support.

Access & Innovation

1) College and Career Prep Classes

We support and facilitate classes to prepare high school students for job interviews and college entrance, along with college essay writing.

2) Nagel After-School Enrichment & Bus Transportation

FHFE provides after-school tutoring and enrichment opportunities for all Nagel students. We pay for the teachers' stipends, the cost of the buses to transport ALL students home as well as the students who participate in after-school clubs (Nagel NEXT).

3) Teacher Grants—Invest in the staff for student development

FHFE funds educational grant requests from Forest Hills teachers and staff that reach students across the district in multiple classrooms and multiple schools. The goal is that the students have access to exceptional learning tools no matter which school you attend.
