Forest Hills ALL IN Collection Drive for IPM Food Pantry breaks record

The Forest Hills Foundation for Education and 9United's 2021 ALL IN Collection Drive for IPM Food Pantry surpassed their stretch goal by more than a ton - literally - by donating 15,064 pounds of non-perishable food and personal care items for IPM clients recently.

"Hunger is invisible and if we can play a role in helping others, we want to do our part," said Stacy Gillard, Executive Director of Forest Hills Foundation for Education. "I love seeing how our entire community, from preschool students to seniors in high school, came together to truly make a difference."

The collection drive was conducted at each of the Forest Hills School District's nine elementary, middle and high schools in October, culminating in the delivery of the collected food donations from all schools to the Turpin-Anderson high school football game on Oct. 22.

"Collaborating with IPM is a valuable experience for our community and our students," added Jean Bode, a school counselor in the Forest Hills School District. "Hosting a collection drive not only supports IPM but provides a wonderful opportunity for leadership and volunteering for all students through-
